

How do Members perform their duties?



Attend Council meetings

Attend Council meetings to raise questions on the work of the Government, enact laws and debate issues concerning public interest.

Participate in the work of committees

Participate in the work of the Legislative Council committees to scrutinize bills and subsidiary legislation, examine and approve public expenditure and monitor the work of the Government.



Handle complaints from the public

Handle complaints from the public who are aggrieved by government actions or policies, and deal with public representations on government policies and legislation as well as other matters of public concern.

Take part in liaison activities

Receive visitors, visiting dignitaries and parliamentary organizations to share knowledge and exchange ideas, as well as take part in meetings and social functions to establish and reinforce links with consular officials and local organizations.
