

Enact laws



The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and Members may introduce bills into the Legislative Council to propose new legislation, and to amend or repeal existing legislation. A bill goes through a three-reading procedure for its passage by the Council.



Know more

Under Article 74 of the Basic Law, bills which do not relate to public expenditure or political structure or the operation of the Government may be introduced individually or jointly by Members of the Legislative Council. As for bills relating to government policies, the written consent of the Chief Executive is required before they can be introduced by Members.
