

LegCo Emblem



Q: Who is responsible for the design of the LegCo Emblem?

A: You must have seen the emblem of LegCo. It was designed by a designer recommended by Mr Bernard CHAN, a former LegCo Member, and was adopted by resolution at the Council meeting held on 8 July 1999. Since then, this emblem appears on the reports, publications, letter-heads, envelopes and souvenirs of the LegCo Secretariat to manifest the independence of the legislature.

Q: What is the design concept?

A: The idea of the LegCo emblem originates from the first character of the Chinese name of the Council “立” and the first letter “L” of the “Legislative Council” . This combination reflects the cosmopolitan nature of Hong Kong where local Chinese and foreign residents thrive alongside each other, and the essences of the Chinese and Western cultures blend in perfect harmony. The grey colour of the character signifies the dignity of LegCo while the yellow background signifies harmony, which is a complement to the font colour.
