



Policy Address

Q: When will the Policy Address be announced?

A: The Chief Executive normally announces his Policy Address at the first meeting of LegCo in each session. The Policy Address outlines the policy objectives of the Government for the following year.

Q: Will LegCo Members deliberate on the Policy Address?

A: Yes, they will. After the Chief Executive has announced his Policy Address, the Chairman of the House Committee will move a Motion of Thanks at a LegCo

meeting to thank the Chief Executive for delivering his Policy Address. This meeting usually lasts for three days. During the debate on the Motion of Thanks, Members will express their opinions on the Policy Address and the government officials will provide responses.

Q: Apart from announcing the Policy Address, will the Chief Executive attend LegCo meetings?

A: Yes. The Chief Executive attends the Question and Answer sessions about four to five times a year to answer questions put to him by Members. The Chief Executive will also attend regularly luncheons hosted by the LegCo President for the Chief Executive, Executive Council Members, senior government officials and LegCo Members, with an aim to enhance communications.
