

Observe Council meetings

Q: Are members of the public allowed to observe the proceedings of LegCo meetings?

A: All LegCo meetings and most of its committee meetings are in public. Members of the public are welcome to observe these meetings. Those interested can call 3919 3399 during office hours to reserve a seat on a first-come-first-served basis. Please be reminded that it is necessary to keep quiet when observing the meetings. Also, no drink, food, photo-taking and filming is allowed.

Q: Can members of the public listen to LegCo meetings via the internet?

A: Sure. Members of the public can listen to all open meetings of LegCo via the internet. Audio records of all open meetings held after October 2002 can also be retrieved. You can visit the LegCo website (www.legco.gov.hk) and click “[Webcast](#)” to listen or watch the meetings. It offers the language versions of floor, Cantonese and English.
