**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion
at the first meeting on 13 February 2001**

The Administration was requested:

- (a) to re-consider the impact of the proposed Central Registration System, under which all documents for registration will have to be lodged at a central registration office at the Queensway Government Offices, on the day-to-day operation of conveyancing solicitors in the New Territories; and
- (b) to provide the names of government departments which are permitted to conduct searches of memorial by name subject to the approval of the Land Registrar, the number and breakdown of such searches as well as the criteria adopted by the Land Registrar in approving these searches.
