

## **Bills Committee on Land Registration (Amendment) Bill 2000**

### **List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion at the meeting on 20 February 2001**

- (1) To provide a copy of the standard application form for authorized departments to conduct name searches of the Land Register.
- (2) To advise the types of information required and the purposes for which such information are sought by individual authorized departments.
- (3) To advise the exceptions under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance which allow the authorized departments to seek the information referred to in the preceding paragraph.
- (4) To inform members of the Administration's decision on the proposal of setting up a mechanism to monitor the number of name searches conducted by individual authorized departments.
- (5) To provide a copy of the bar-coded memorial form.
- (6) To advise the effects of the withheld/stopped deeds on the parties concerned.
- (7) To re-consider the Heung Yee Kuk's suggestion of reducing the proposed period for stopped deeds to be pending from 12 to six months subject to extension with reasons satisfactory to the Land Registrar.
- (8) To consider introducing a Committee Stage amendment to include in the Bill regular types of registrable certified copy documents currently accepted by the Land Registry with a view to reducing the need for Land Registry Circular Memorandum in future.
