Legislative issues relating to the proposed section 6(8) of the Bill

2. The Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
3. The Committee noted the information paper on "Criteria for determining whether a statutory instrument is subsidiary legislation" prepared by Assistant Legal Adviser 3.
4. At the suggestion of the Chairman, the Committee agreed that the legislative issue concerning Government's policy for determining whether a statutory instrument was subsidiary legislation should be referred to the Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services (AJLS) for consideration. Ms Margaret NG, Chairman of the AJLS Panel, said that she would consult the Panel as to how the issue should be followed up.

Draft Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) proposed by the Administration

5. The Committee agreed to the draft CSAs proposed by the Administration for the new sections 6(7) and (8).

6. The Committee agreed to report its deliberations to the House Committee on 17 May 2002. The Administration would advise in due course the intended date for resumption of Second Reading debate on the Bill.
