Project code	Project description	Recommendation
22CD PWSC(2000-01)49 (Head 707)	North West New Territories development – main drainage channels for Yuen Long and Kam Tin – remainder, phase 4	To recommend to Finance Committee – (a) the upgrading of part of 22CD as 113CD , entitled “Main drainage channels for Yuen Long and Kam Tin – Sham Chung Channel”, to Category A at an estimated cost of \$93.7 million in money-of-the-day prices; and (b) the retention of the remainder of 22CD , re-titled “Main drainage channels for Yuen Long and Kam Tin – Tin Tsuen Channel”, in Category B.
81CD PWSC(2000-01)50 (Head 707)	Main drainage channels for Yuen Long and Kam Tin stage 2 – remainder	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of 81CD to Category A at an estimated cost of \$291.6 million in money-of-the-day prices.
90WC PWSC(2000-01)51 (Head 709)	Replacement and rehabilitation of water mains, stage 1 phase 1	To recommend to Finance Committee – (a) the upgrading of part of 90WC as 175WC , entitled “Replacement and rehabilitation of water mains, stage 1 phase 1 (part 1) works in Sheung Shui, Tai Po, Sha Tin and Mong Kok”, to Category A at an estimated cost of \$115.3 million in money-of-the-day prices; and (b) the retention of the remainder of 90WC in Category B.

170BF PWSC(2000-01)52 (Head 711)	Fire station-cum-ambulance depot in Area 112, Tin Shui Wai	To recommend to Finance Committee the upgrading of 170BF to Category A at an estimated cost of \$86.1 million in money-of-the-day prices for the construction of a 5-bay fire station-cum-ambulance depot in Area 112, Tin Shui Wai.
