Supplementary information on 183SC - Community hall at Yau Tong Estate Redevelopment, phase 4

#### **INTRODUCTION**

When Members considered the paper referenced PWSC(2001-02)50 on **183SC** at the Public Works Subcommittee meeting on 20 June 2001, the Administration undertook to provide information on furniture and equipment (F&E) provided under **183SC**.

#### THE ADMINISTRATION'S RESPONSE

2. The proposed community hall at Yau Tong Estate will have the Home Affairs Department Yau Tong Sub-office and comprise a multi-purpose hall, a meeting room, a store room, a conference room, an office, and other ancillary facilities. A breakdown of the F&E estimate is as follows -

3. The proposed air-conditioned multi-purpose hall with stage will have up-to-date built-in lighting, stage curtains, P.A. systems and acoustic systems suitable for performance, seminar and ceremony purposes. Mattresses, vaulting box and buck, table for table tennis and badminton stand and net will also be provided in the hall for a wide range of physical activities such as gymnastics, table-tennis and badminton. The proposed air-conditioned meeting room will have meeting tables and wyte-board for meeting and small group discussion purposes with capacity of about 20 persons. The proposed air-conditioned conference room will be equipped with projectors, screens and conference tables for about 50 persons. The whole range of facilities in the respective hall and rooms will be available to registered non-profit-making organisations free of charge and private parties at modest fees upon booking. Similar facilities are available to most newly built community halls of the Government. Based on previous experience, the Administration considers these facilities suitable and adequate to meet public aspirations.
