## **I Election of Chairman**

Mr Bernard CHAN, the Member who had the highest precedence in the Council amongst those who were present at the meeting, presided over the election of the Chairman for the Subcommittee. Mr Bernard CHAN invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Subcommittee. Nominated by Miss CHOY So-yuk and seconded by Mr Bernard CHAN, Mr CHAN Kam-lam accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, Mr CHAN Kam-lam was elected Chairman of the Subcommittee.

Members noted that the scrutiny period of 28 days for the amendment regulation would expire after the last Council meeting in the current legislative session on 11 July 2001, and that according to section 34 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap.1), the scrutiny period should be deemed to extend to and expire on the day after the second Council meeting in the next session.

3. Members agreed to hold the next two meetings at 10:45 am on 12 September 2001 and at 2:30 pm on 21 September 2001 and to invite deputations to give views at the meeting on 12 September 2001.
