Dimensions	Concepts	Topics
Human development	Sexual identity and orientation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discussion and identification of sexual orientation - Dispelling fears and biases - Sexual identity, sex-role behaviour, gender identity, gender-role behaviour (tomboy, sissy), sexual orientation, lifestyle
Health and behaviour	Sexual habits and behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Appreciate diversity in human sexual behaviour, critically review existing social prejudices against sexual minorities - Avoiding behaviour that exhibits prejudice and bigotry, demonstrating tolerance for people with different sexual values and lifestyles - Variations in sexual behaviour: homosexuality, bisexuality, heterosexuality
Marriage and family	Marriage and lifetime commitments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lifestyle choices: single, married with no children, homosexual, heterosexual, bisexual, celibate, etc.
Society and culture	Sex, morality and ethics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Appreciation and fairness in understanding people who have different lifestyles or sex styles or sexual orientation: single people, married couples who decide not to have children, homosexuals, heterosexuals, bisexuals, celibates
