**LegCo Panel on Security
Meeting on 19 October 2000**

At the captioned Meeting, we undertook to provide Members with statistics showing the tolerance level of young people on corruption. I am sending you with this letter two relevant tables extracted from the ICAC Annual Survey 2000. Both tables show that a high percentage of young people i.e. 15 – 24 in terms of age groups, and students in terms of occupation groups think that corruption is not prevalent in Hong Kong and they are intolerant of corruption in Hong Kong. Their ratings are generally higher than the rest of the sampled population.
