SCALE OF FARES NOTICE

CITYBUS LIMITED

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) of the Public Bus Services Ordinance ('the Ordinance'), the Chief Executive in Council has determined a new scale of fares for carriage of passengers specified in Part I of the Schedule to take effect on 1 December 1997. The completed new scale of fares together with the baggage and goods fares in Part I and the concession fares in Part II of the Schedule, and the maximum rate of increase which may be permitted by the Commissioner for Transport under the Ordinance as stipulated in Part III of the Schedule are published for general information.

(b)	No additional charge shall be made in respect of one bamboo or wooden pole not exceeding 60 millimetres in diameter and 1.5 metres in length.		
(c)	No passenger shall be accompanied by more than 5 kilograms of fresh fish or dried fish.

- (a) Children below the age of 12 years are charged on every service one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest 10 cents above.
 - (b) Children below the age of 4 years, if accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, are carried free of charge. Not more than two children are carried free of charge by any one adult.
 - (c) Passengers over the age of 60 are charged, on every service except cross harbour and recreation services, one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above. Passengers aged 65 or above are charged on cross harbour service one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest 10 cents above.

4. The maximum rate of increase is 50% of the scale of fares specified in Part I.
5. The scale of fares published in the *Gazette* for general information in the Schedule G.N. 879 of 1996 is hereby superseded.

(B) In the case where the journey distance of an express route is shorter than that of an existing non-express route serving broadly the same destinations, the journey distance of the non-express route shall be adopted for the purpose of determining the fare of the express route.

2. Baggage and Goods Fares

- (a) On any route, a passenger may carry free of charge a package or packages of a total weight not exceeding 5 kilograms and a total volume not exceeding 0.1 cubic metre so long as such package or packages may be safely or conveniently carried.
- (b) On certain New Territories Rural Routes specified in the Schedule of Services, accompanied luggage or goods may be carried upon payment of the following charges:—
- (i) for luggage or goods of a total weight not exceeding 23 kilograms or size not exceeding 0.15 cubic metre—half the adult single fare in respect of the route or section of the route on which the luggage or goods are carried;
 - (ii) for luggage or goods of a total weight exceeding 23 kilograms but not exceeding 45 kilograms—the full adult single fare in respect of the route or section of the route on which the luggage or goods are carried.
- (c) No additional charge shall be made in respect of one bamboo or wooden pole not exceeding 60 millimetres in diameter and 1.5 metres in length.
- (d) No passenger shall be accompanied by more than 5 kilograms of fresh fish or dried fish.

Part II

3. Concession Fares

- (a) Children below the age of 12 years are charged, on every service except the Boundary Services, one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.
- (b) Children below the age of 4 years, if accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, are carried free of charge. Not more than two children are carried free of charge by any one adult.
- (c) Passengers aged 65 or above are charged, on every service except the Airport Services and the Boundary Services, one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.

Part III

4. The maximum rate of increase is 50% of the scale of fares specified in Part I.
