Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Markets) (Designation and Amendment of Tenth Schedule) (No. 2) Order 2001 (Made under section 79(5) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Cessation of designation as public markets

The Chai Wan Temporary Market and the Lee Chung Street Cooked Food Market shall cease to be designated as public markets.
