Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Cargo Ship Construction and Survey) (Ships Built on or after 1 September 1984) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulation 2001
(Made under section 96 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance (Cap. 369))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Secretary for Economic Services by notice published in the Gazette.

2. Emergency supplies

Regulation 47(1)(a) of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Cargo Ship Construction and Survey) (Ships Built On or After 1 September 1984) Regulations (Cap. 369 sub. leg.) is repealed and the following substituted---

"(a) for a period of 3 hours, emergency lighting required to be provided at the muster and embarkation stations and alleyways, stairways and exits giving access to the muster and embarkation stations, and at each survival craft, its launching appliance, and the area of water into which the survival craft is to be launched;"

Explanatory Note

The main purpose of this Regulation is to amend the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Cargo Ship Construction and Survey) (Ships Built On or After 1 September 1984) Regulations (Cap. 369 sub. leg.) consequential to the repeal of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Life-Saving Appliances) (Ships Built Before 1 July 1986) Regulations (Cap. 369 sub. leg.) and the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Life-Saving Appliances) (Ships Built On or After 1 July 1986) Regulations (Cap. 369 sub. leg.).
