## L.N. 262 of 2000

Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Markets) (Designation and Amendment of Tenth Schedule) Order 2000

(Made under section 79(5) of the Public Health and

Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Cessation of designation as public markets

Stanley Market, Wan Chai Temporary Market, Hip Wo Street Temporary Market and Yuen Ling Market shall cease to be designated as public markets.

## 2. Public Markets

The Tenth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended by repealing---

"Stanley Market 赤柱街市

Wan Chai Temporary Market 灣仔臨時街市

Hip Wo Street Temporary Market 協和街臨時街市

Yuen Ling Market 元續街市".
