

L.N. 289 of 2000

Public Health And Municipal Services (Fees and Charges) (Museums) Regulation  
(Made under section 124J of the Public Health and  
Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 10 December 2000.

2. Interpretation

In this Regulation, "Designated Museums" (指定博物館) means the buildings, parts of buildings or places designated as museums and listed in the Schedule to the Designation of Museums Order (Cap. 132 sub. leg.).

3. Fees and charges

The fees specified in column 3 of the Schedule are payable in respect of the matters described in column 2 of the Schedule.

1. Designated Museums

(a) A pass for one year for an unlimited number of entries to Designated Museums (except Space Theatre of the Hong Kong Space Museum) for---

(i) a full-time student, disabled person or a person aged 60 or above 50

(ii) members of the same family, up to a maximum of 4 persons 200

(iii) any other person 100

(b) A pass for 6 months for an unlimited number of entries to Designated Museums (except Space Theatre of the Hong Kong Space Museum) for---

(i) a full-time student, disabled person or a person aged 60 or above 25

(ii) any other person 50

(c) A pass for one month for an unlimited number of entries to Designated Museums (except Space Theatre of the Hong Kong Space Museum) for one person 50

(d) A pass for one week for an unlimited number of entries to Designated Museums (except Space Theatre of the Hong Kong Space Museum) for one person 30

2. The Hong Kong Heritage Museum

(a) Admission fee (except for Wednesday) for a single entry for---

(i) a full-time student, disabled person or a person aged 60 or above 5

(ii) a group of 20 or more persons 7 per person

(iii) any other person aged 4 or above 10

Explanatory Note

The object of this Regulation is to provide for ---

(a) the fees and charges payable for a museum pass for one year, 6 months, one month or one week for admission to the museums listed in the Schedule to the Designation of Museums Order (Cap. 132 sub. leg.); and

(b) the admission fee payable for the Hong Kong Heritage Museum in Shatin which is scheduled to open in December 2000.
