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**RESOLUTION**

(Under section 29 of the Pharmacy  
and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138))

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RESOLVED that the following Regulations, made by the Pharmacy  
and Poisons Board on 18 June 2001, be approved -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment)(No. 4)  
Regulation 2001; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment)(No. 3) Regulation 2001.

**PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT)(NO. 4) REGULATION 2001**

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29  
of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138)  
subject to the approval of the Legislative  
Council)

**1. Substances falling within the Poisons List  
to which special restrictions apply under  
regulations 3 and 5**

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations  
(Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended in part A by adding -

"Atosiban; its salts  
Levetiracetam; its salts  
Lopinavir; its salts  
Nateglinide; its salts; its esters  
Risedronic acid; its salts  
Sirolimus; its salts".

**2. Substances required by regulation 9 to be sold  
by retail only upon a prescription given  
by a registered medical practitioner,  
registered dentist or registered  
veterinary surgeon**

The Third Schedule is amended in part A by adding -

"Atosiban; its salts  
Levetiracetam; its salts  
Lopinavir; its salts  
Nateglinide; its salts; its esters  
Risedronic acid; its salts  
Sirolimus; its salts".

Risedronic acid; its salts

Sirolimus; its salts".
