

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 29 of the Pharmacy and
Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138))

RESOLVED that the following Regulations, made by the Pharmacy
and Poisons Board on 4 October 2000, be approved -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment)(No. 4)
Regulation 2000; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment)(No. 4) Regulation
2000.

PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT)(NO. 4) REGULATION 2000

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138) subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

1. Substances falling within the Poisons List to which special restrictions apply under regulations 3 and 5

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended in part A by adding -

"Bupropion; its salts
Cetrorelix; its salts; its esters; their salts
Exemestane; its salts
Moxifloxacin; its salts
Rosiglitazone; its salts
Temozolomide; its salts".

2. Substances required by regulation 9 to be sold by retail only upon a prescription given by a registered medical practitioner, registered dentist or registered veterinary surgeon

The Third Schedule is amended in part A by adding -

"Bupropion; its salts
Cetrorelix; its salts; its esters; their salts
Exemestane; its salts
Moxifloxacin; its salts
Rosiglitazone; its salts
Temozolomide; its salts".
