

**Bills Committee on
Import and Export (Electronic Transactions) Bill 2001**

**List of follow-up actions arising from discussion
at the meeting on 30 May 2002**

- (1) To confirm whether it is the policy objective of the Guangdong Customs Sub-Administration to mandate the submission of manifests in electronic form and whether Nan Fang is the sole provider of electronic service for manifest submission in all ports within the Pearl River Delta Region.
- (2) To advise the number and locations of ports included under the trial scheme for electronic submission of manifests conducted by the Guangzhou Customs.
- (3) To refine the drafting of proposed sections 15(1B) and (1C) of the Import and Export Ordinance (the Ordinance) to reflect the intention of avoiding duplication in the submission of manifests.
- (4) To refine the drafting of proposed section 19(1) of the Ordinance to make it an option for the owner of any vessel to provide in paper form or a written list showing every port or place at which the vessel has called during the period of three months immediately preceding the date of its arrival in Hong Kong.
