# List of follow-up actions to be taken by the Administration

# 1. <u>Cross-referencing the Bill and the Convention</u>

To facilitate the Bills Committee's consideration of the need to set out the full text of the Convention in Schedule 1 to the Bill, please provide a table cross-referencing the Bill and the relevant parts of the Convention.

### 2. Addition of the definitions of critical terms in clause 2

Certain critical terms such as "Chemical Weapons" and "Facility" are defined in the Convention, but not in clause 2 (Interpretation) of the Bill. Please consider adding the definitions of such terms in clause 2 by referring to the definitions provided in the Convention.

### 3. <u>Clause 5(e) and (f)</u>

Clause 5(f) provides that no person shall assist, encourage or induce, in any way, anyone to engage in any activity prohibited under the Convention. In this connection:

- (a) please review whether it is appropriate to use the term "encourage" in the context of clause 5(f) and its implications, and whether the term is commonly used in local legislation; and
- (b) please consider whether the defence provision under clause 29(2), which is applicable to clause 5(a), (b), (c) or (d), should also be applicable to clause 5(e) and (f).
