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## **I. Meeting with the Administration**

1. The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -
  - (a) to consider whether clause 4(1)(d) should be singled out in line with the drafting of the defence provisions in the proposed Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) at Annex II of the paper entitled "Administration's Response to Issues Raised at the Meeting on 29 May 2003 (LC paper No. CB(2)2303/02-03(01) and review the drafting of the clause to ensure consistency with other defence clauses;
  - (b) to provide in due course a table summarizing the countries which exempted military aircraft, military vehicles or a ship of war from entry, search and seizure under warrant;
  - (c) to clarify whether money earned from child pornography was liable to forfeiture;

- (d) to propose consequential amendment to clause 10(2) as a result of the proposed CSAs to clause 4;
- (e) to propose CSA to new section 153P(3) under clause 16, taking into account offences set out in the new Schedule 2 that involved the defendant procuring a child for sexual exploitation by a third person, such as the offence under section 130 of the Crimes Ordinance;
- (f) to set out the individual sexual offences of the Crimes Ordinance which were not included in the new Schedule 2 under clause 18 and the reasons behind;
- (g) to consider providing in the Bill the same protection for mentally incapacitated persons of age over 16; and
- (h) to provide a full set of draft CSAs for the consideration of the Bills Committee at the next meeting.

3. Members agreed that the next three meetings would be held on 11 June 2003 at 8:30 am, 16 June 2003 at 10:45 am and 19 June 2003 at 8:30 am.
4. The meeting ended at 12:50 pm.
