## **Bills**

### **First Reading**

#### **Evidence (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2002**

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

### **Second Reading**

#### **Evidence (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2002**

The Secretary for Justice moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

#### **Marine Fish Culture (Amendment) Bill 2002**

### **Resumption of Second Reading debate**

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 17 April 2002 resumed.

Hon WONG Yung-kan declared his interest as the chairman of the Federation of Hong Kong Aquaculture Association, a member of the Advisory Committee on Agriculture and Fisheries and the chairman of its Aquaculture Subcommittee, and spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Environment and Food replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

### Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Marine Fish Culture (Amendment) Bill 2002**.

Question that clauses 1, 3, 4 and 6 to 9 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2 and 5 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for the Environment and Food moved amendments to clauses 2 and 5 and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2 and 5, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that the schedule stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for the Environment and Food moved an amendment to the schedule and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendment put and agreed to.

Question that the schedule, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

### Third Reading

The Secretary for the Environment and Food reported that

the **Marine Fish Culture (Amendment) Bill 2002**

had passed through the Committee with amendments. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

## Motions

### Government motion

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council supports the accountability system for principal officials.

Question on the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs' motion proposed.

The Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion.

The President stated that Hon Martin LEE would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Martin LEE moved the following amendment to the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs' motion and addressed the Council:

To add "which is grounded in a democratic political system based on universal suffrage and is accountable to the Legislative Council" after "That this Council supports the accountability system for principal officials".

Question on Hon Martin LEE's amendment to the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs' motion proposed.

Four Members and Ir Dr Hon HO Chung-tai spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Ir Dr Hon HO Chung-tai was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:10 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Another five Members and Hon SZETO Wah spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 7:26 pm, while Hon SZETO Wah was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 13 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

The President suspended the meeting at 9:55 pm.

The Council resumed at 2:30 pm on 30 May 2002 and continued to debate the Government motion moved by the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs and the amendment to the motion moved by Hon Martin LEE.



18 further Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

The Secretary for Justice and the Secretary for the Civil Service spoke on the motion and the amendment.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the amendment.

Question on Hon Martin LEE's amendment to the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs's motion put.

Hon Martin LEE claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 28 were present, five were in favour of the amendment, 21 against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 27 were present, 14 were in favour of the amendment and 12 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs replied.

Question on the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs' motion put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 55 Members were present, 34 were in favour of the motion, 19 against it and one abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

## **Members' Bills**

### **First Reading**

#### **CITIC Ka Wah Bank Limited (Merger) Bill**

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President stated that as the CITIC Ka Wah Bank Limited (Merger) Bill presented by Dr Hon David LI related to Government policies, in accordance with Rule 54(1) of the Rules of Procedure, the signification of the written consent of the Chief Executive by the Secretary for Financial Services was required before the Council entered upon consideration of the second reading of the Bill.

The Secretary for Financial Services confirmed that the Chief Executive had given his written consent for the CITIC Ka Wah Bank Limited (Merger) Bill to be introduced into this Council.

### **Second Reading**

#### **CITIC Ka Wah Bank Limited (Merger) Bill**

Dr Hon David LI moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

### **Members' Motions**

#### **Promoting producer and professional services**

Hon Ambrose LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the Financial Secretary stated in his speech on the 2002-03 Budget that producer and professional services are a major driving force of Hong Kong's economic development, this Council urges the Government to take proactive measures to call together senior officials of various departments and representatives of the relevant sectors to render full assistance to the producer and professional services sectors in developing their markets and, through the Government's offices established in the Mainland, to actively reflect to and pursue with the Mainland authorities the common concerns of Hong Kong businessmen about trade and commercial issues, so as to seize more effectively the business opportunities that arise from increased trade activities between Hong Kong and the Mainland.

While Hon Ambrose LAU was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:58 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

Nine Members and the Secretary for Commerce and Industry spoke on the motion.

At 8:00 pm, while the Secretary for Commerce and Industry was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Hon Ambrose LAU replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

#### **The 4 June incident**

Hon SZETO Wah moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges that: the 4 June incident be not forgotten and the 1989 pro-democracy movement be vindicated.

Question on the motion proposed.

13 Members spoke on the motion.

Hon SZETO Wah replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Albert HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 21 were present, four were in favour of the motion, eight against it and nine abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 14 were in favour of the motion and nine against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

#### **Next Meeting**

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 5 June 2002 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 9:40 pm.
