### Second Reading

#### **Revenue Bill 2002**

#### Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 17 April 2002 resumed.

Hon Margaret NG, Chairman of the Bills Committee to study bills including the Revenue Bill 2002, addressed the Council on the Bills Committee's Report in respect of the Bill.

Seven Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Treasury replied.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon Tommy CHEUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 48 Members were present, 37 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

### Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Revenue Bill 2002**.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

**Third Reading**

The Secretary for the Treasury reported that

the **Revenue Bill 2002**

had passed through the Committee without amendment. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

**Revenue (No. 2) Bill 2002**

**Resumption of Second Reading debate**

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 17 April 2002 resumed.

Hon Margaret NG, Chairman of the Bills Committee to study bills including the Revenue (No. 2) Bill 2002, addressed the Council on the Bills Committee's Report in respect of the Bill.

A Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Treasury replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

**Committee Stage**

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Revenue (No. 2) Bill 2002**.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

### **Noise Control (Amendment) Bill 2001**

#### **Resumption of Second Reading debate**

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 27 June 2001 resumed.

Hon IP Kwok-him, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Noise Control (Amendment) Bill 2001, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Another six Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Environment and Food replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

#### **Committee Stage**

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Noise Control (Amendment) Bill 2001**.

Question that clauses 1, 2 and 3 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for the Environment and Food moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1, 2 and 3, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

#### **Third Reading**

The Secretary for the Environment and Food reported that

the **Noise Control (Amendment) Bill 2001**

had passed through the Committee with amendments. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

## **Employees Compensation Assistance (Amendment) Bill 2002**

### **Resumption of Second Reading debate**

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 27 February 2002 resumed.

Hon Audrey EU, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Employees Compensation Assistance (Amendment) Bill 2002, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, she spoke on the Bill in her personal capacity as a Member.

While Hon Audrey EU was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:35 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Another Member and Hon LEUNG Fu-wah spoke on the Bill.

At 6:50 pm, while Hon LEUNG Fu-wah was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Five further Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

### **Committee Stage**

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Employees Compensation Assistance (Amendment) Bill 2002**.

Question that clauses 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, 24 to 28, 31 and 33 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1, 7, 8, 14, 17, 19, 23, 29, 30 and 32 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1, 7, 8, 14, 17, 19, 23, 29, 30 and 32, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 3 and 12 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved amendments to clauses 3 and 12 and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Hon Audrey EU moved further amendments to clauses 3 and 12 and addressed the Committee.

Four Members and the Secretary for Education and Manpower spoke on the amendments.

Hon Audrey EU spoke again.

Question on the amendments put.

Hon LEE Cheuk-yan claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the Committee to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The Chairman announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, seven were in favour of the amendments and 17 against them; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, 15 were in favour of the amendments and 10 against them. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendments were negatived.

Question that clauses 3 and 12, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that the schedule stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

### **Third Reading**

The Secretary for Education and Manpower reported that

the **Employees Compensation Assistance (Amendment) Bill 2002**

had passed through the Committee with amendments. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

**Motions**

**Proposed resolution under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance**

The Secretary for Health and Welfare moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

(a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment)(No. 2) Regulation 2002; and

(b) the Poisons List (Amendment)(No. 2) Regulation 2002,

made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 28 May 2002 be approved.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

**Proposed resolution under the Factories and Industrial Undertakings Ordinance**

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Factories and Industrial Undertakings (Woodworking Machinery)(Amendment) Regulation 2002, made by the Commissioner for Labour on 5 June 2002, be approved.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

**Proposed resolution under the Buildings Ordinance**

The Secretary for Planning and Lands moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Fifth Schedule to the Buildings Ordinance be amended -

(a) by repealing area number 3 and substituting -

"3. The railway protection areas along the Mass Transit Railway lines being -

(a) the areas delineated and shown edged black on the plans numbered MTR/G/1 to 3, MTR/RP/1 to 22, MTR/RP/25 to 27, MTR/RP/30 to 46, MTR/RP/50 to 55, MTR/RP/60 to 66 and MTR/RP/101 to 170, dated 29 June 1998, signed by the Secretary for Planning, Environment and Lands and deposited in the Land Registry; and

(b) the areas delineated and shown edged black on the plans numbered MTR/G/4, MTR/RP/23 Rev. A, MTR/RP/24 Rev. A, MTR/RP/28 Rev. A, MTR/RP/29 Rev. A, MTR/RP/56 Rev. A, MTR/RP/57 Rev. A, MTR/RP/58 Rev. A, MTR/RP/59 Rev. A and MTR/RP/202 to 223, dated 29 May 2002, signed by the Secretary for Planning and Lands and deposited in the Land Registry.";

(b) in area number 4, by repealing "以" .

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

### **Members' Motions**

#### **Report on Higher Education in Hong Kong**

Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council notes the report of the University Grants Committee entitled "Higher Education in Hong Kong".

While Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 8:19 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

Six Members and Hon LI Fung-ying spoke on the motion.

At 9:02 pm, while Hon LI Fung-ying was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 10 Members and the Secretary for Education and Manpower spoke on the motion.

Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

**Local community economy**

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, in order to promote Hong Kong's economy and domestic consumption and to create more employment opportunities, this Council urges that, to complement the overall socio-economic situation, the Government adopt proactive measures to promote the development of the local community economy and spare no efforts in improving the business environment, in order to strengthen the local community economy.

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon CHAN Yuen-han and Hon Fred LI would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han and Hon Fred LI spoke respectively on the motion and their amendments.

16 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG spoke on the amendments.

The Financial Secretary spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han moved the following amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion:

To add "diversified development of" after "That, in order to promote"; to delete "adopt proactive measures" after "the Government", and substitute with "amend outdated policies and statutory requirements, enhance co-ordination among the various departments and optimize the use of existing local resources, so as"; and to delete "improving the" after "and spare no efforts in", and substitute with "creating a better and fair".

Question on Hon CHAN Yuen-han's amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion proposed and put and agreed to.

The President granted leave for Hon Fred LI to revise and explain to the Council the terms of his amendment.

Hon Fred LI moved the following revised amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion as amended by Hon CHAN Yuen-han, and explained the revised wording of his amendment to the Council.

To delete "strengthen" after "creating a better and fair business environment, in order to", and substitute with "enable small and medium enterprises to participate actively in".

Question on Hon Fred LI's further amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion as amended by Hon CHAN Yuen-han proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG replied.

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion as amended by Hon CHAN Yuen-han and Hon Fred LI put and agreed to.

**Next Meeting**

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 3 July 2002 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 12:52 am on 27 June 2002.
