REGULATION 2002**

1. Terms of office of Council members

Section 9(3) of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Regulation (Cap. 419 sub. leg.) is repealed.

Explanatory Note

Section 9(3) of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Regulation (Cap. 419 sub. leg.) provides that a Fellow of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine shall not serve on the Council of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine for a continuous period of more than 8 years. This Regulation repeals that provision so as to remove that restriction.
