Ouestion: How much can be saved in the new financial year by deleting three, one and eight

permanent posts respectively under Programmes (1), (2) and (3)? After the deletion of

these posts, how will the duties be rearranged?

Reply:

In 2002-03, we plan to delete a total of 16 posts. As we also plan to create 4 new posts, the net number of post to be deleted is therefore 12. Based on the notional annual mid-point salary values of the 16 deleted posts, it is estimated that a total of \$2.816 m in annual salary can be saved in the new financial year.

In order to ensure that the deletion of the above posts will not compromise the quality of our services, the department has reviewed and streamlined existing working procedures, appropriately re-engineered and arranged for service outsourcing, and provided existing staff with appropriate training and equipment needed for office automation. All these measures aim at enhancing efficiency and productivity.
