CHIEF EXECUTIVE ELECTION (ELECTION PETITION) RULES

RESOLVED that the Chief Executive Election (Election
Petition) Rules, published in the Gazette as Legal
Notice No. 241 of 2001 and laid on the table of the
Legislative Council on 21 November 2001, be amended -

- (a) in section 9(2), by repealing "控罪" and
substituting "指控";
- (b) in section 15 -
 - (i) in subsection (1)(b) and (c), by
repealing "due to his death or
otherwise";
 - (ii) in subsection (2), by repealing "the
proceedings for a petition shall be" and
substituting "a petition is".
