LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE
HONG KONG SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE REGION

Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, to the extent that it provides for a
Motion of Thanks to be moved at a meeting not less than 14 days after the Chief
Executive has presented a Policy Address to the Council, be suspended to
enable a Motion of Thanks to be moved at the Legislative Council meeting of
17 October 2001.
