By adding in Part 6 -

"14A. Supplementary provisions  
applicable to licences  
mentioned in section 5(1)  
or 7

(1) Without prejudice to the  
generality of conditions and exceptions

which may be specified in a licence  
mentioned in section 5(1) -

(a) such conditions may  
relate to specifying the  
manner in which the funds  
to which the licence  
relates shall be held  
from time to time; and

(b) such exceptions may  
relate but are not  
limited to -

(i) the reasonable  
living  
expenses;

(ii) the reasonable  
legal expenses;  
and

(iii) the payments  
liable to be  
made under the  
Employment  
Ordinance (Cap.  
57),  
of any person by, for or  
on behalf of whom the  
funds are held.

(2) Without prejudice to the  
generality of conditions and exceptions  
which may be specified in a licence  
mentioned in section 7, such exceptions  
may relate to the reasonable living  
expenses, reasonable legal expenses and  
the payments liable to be made under the  
Employment Ordinance (Cap. 57) of the  
person second-mentioned in that section  
to which the licence relates."
