I. Election of Chairman

Ms Cyd HO invited nominations for the chairmanship. Ms Emily LAU nominated Ms Cyd HO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Michael FUNG. Ms Cyd HO accepted the nomination.

2. Ir Dr Raymond HO took over the chair and presided over the election of Chairman. Mr WONG Yung-kan nominated Miss CHOY So-yuk and Miss CHAN Yuen-han seconded the nomination. Miss CHOY So-yuk accepted the nomination.

3. As there were two nominations, Ir Dr Raymond HO announced a vote by secret ballot. Of the members present, eight voted for Miss CHOY So-yuk and seven voted for Ms Cyd HO. Miss CHOY So-yuk was declared Chairman of the Panel.

4. Miss CHOY So-yuk took over the chair.

5. Miss CHOY So-yuk invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Ms Cyd HO was nominated by Mr LAW Chi-kwong and seconded by Mr LAU Kong-wah. Ms Cyd HO accepted the nomination.

6. There being no other nomination, Ms Cyd HO was declared Deputy Chairman of the Panel.
