“Hong Kong 2001 Population Census - Basic Tables for District Council Districts” published

“Hong Kong 2001 Population Census - Basic Tables for District Council Districts”, compiled by the Census and Statistics Department based on the results of the 2001 Population Census, is published today (December 31).

This report provides statistics on the socio-economic characteristics of the population in Hong Kong by District Council district. The report is organized into three parts. The first part “Summary Statistics” provides key statistics on the population and households in each District Council district. The second part “Age-sex Profile” contains statistics of the population in each District Council district with breakdown by age and sex. Detailed population and household characteristics in each District Council district are presented in the third part “Basic Tables”.

The report is in bilingual form and is available at \$34 per copy. It can be purchased in person from:
