# Quarterly Report on The Admission of Talents Scheme

(From 1 October 2001 to 31 December 2001)

## **Employment applications**

Between 1 October and 31 December 2001, 34 entry applications for employment were received under the Scheme. In the same period, 26 applications were approved and 21 were refused or withdrawn. As at end of December 2001, 10 applications were under processing.

## **Employers**

3. A total of twenty-three employers are involved. The paid-up capital of five of them is below HK\$1 million; three are in the range of HK\$1 million to below HK\$10 million; six are in the range of HK\$10 million to below HK\$100 million; four are over HK\$100 million. Of the remaining five employers, three are local universities/tertiary education institution and two are non-profit making companies exempted from business registration.

## Educational attainment

4. Fifteen of the approved talents are holders of doctoral degree. Seven hold master degree and four hold bachelor degree having relevant professional qualifications, multifarious professional publications and substantial working experience in their respective fields.
