- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulation 2001; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulation 2001, made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 26 November 2001 be approved.

**PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT)(NO. 5)  
REGULATION 2001**

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29  
of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138)  
subject to the approval of the  
Legislative Council)

**1. Substances falling within the Poisons List  
to which special restrictions apply under  
regulations 3 and 5**

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap.  
138 sub. leg.) is amended in part A by adding -

"Artemether; its salts  
Etanercept  
Lumefantrine; its salts  
Moxonidine; its salts  
Rilmenidine; its salts  
Ziprasidone; its salts  
Zoledronic acid; its salts".

**2. Substances required by regulation 9 to be  
sold by retail only upon a prescription  
given by a registered medical  
practitioner, registered  
dentist or registered  
veterinary surgeon**

The Third Schedule is amended in part A by adding -

"Artemether; its salts  
Etanercept  
Lumefantrine; its salts  
Moxonidine; its salts  
Rilmenidine; its salts

Ziprasidone; its salts

Zoledronic acid; its salts".

- (a) in the item relating to "Antihistamine substances", by  
adding -

"Desloratadine";

- (b) by adding -

"Artemether; its salts

Etanercept

Lumefantrine; its salts

Moxonidine; its salts

Rilmenidine; its salts

Ziprasidone; its salts

Zoledronic acid; its salts".
