# Second Reading

Immigration (Amendment) Bill 2001

### Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 28 November 2001 resumed.

Hon James TO, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Immigration (Amendment) Bill 2001, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Five more Members and the Secretary for Justice spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Security replied.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon Margaret NG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 52 Members were present, 31 were in favour of the motion and 20 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

# Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Immigration** (Amendment) Bill 2001.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

# Third Reading

The Secretary for Security reported that

the Immigration (Amendment) Bill 2001

had passed through the Committee without amendment. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Hon Margaret NG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 51 Members were present, 30 were in favour of the motion and 20 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the third time and passed.

# Developing offshore fishing industry

Hon WONG Yung-kan moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as Hong Kong's inshore fishing industry has been wilting continuously in recent years as a result of dwindling marine resources in the South China Sea, the livelihood of fishermen engaging in capture fishery has been seriously affected; moreover, many coastal countries or areas in the world have been actively developing offshore fishing for more than a decade, and a consultancy study on the feasibility of offshore fishing commissioned earlier by the Government has also concluded that Hong Kong has the potential for developing offshore fishing, this Council urges the Government expeditiously formulate a policy on developing offshore fishing, including the provision of technical support, loan arrangements, manpower training and liaison with the relevant overseas and Mainland authorities, so as to ensure the restructuring of the local fishing industry towards offshore fishing, thereby keeping in tune with the direction of China's fishing policy and enhancing the international status of Hong Kong's fishing industry.

While Hon WONG Yung-kan was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 5:16 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

14 Members and the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion.

At 6:49 pm, while the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Hon WONG Yung-kan replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

### Emissions trading

Hon CHOY So-yuk moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to embark on, as soon as possible, a study on the feasibility of implementing emissions trading in Hong Kong or jointly with the neighbouring territories, and to implement as far as possible specific pilot schemes to ascertain whether conditions exist in the region for adopting emissions trading as a means to control the total volume of emissions.

Question on the motion proposed.

11 Members and the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works spoke on the motion.

Hon CHOY So-yuk replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.
