#### Proposed resolution under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment)(No. 4) Regulation 2002; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment)(No. 4) Regulation 2002,

made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 22 October 2002, be approved.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

## Members' Motions

#### Reducing electricity and gas tariffs

Hon Fred LI moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to expeditiously discuss with the two power companies and Town Gas and encourage them to take account of their respective operating conditions and reduce their tariffs or offer concessions to users, thereby alleviating the burden on the public and the commercial and industrial sectors.

Question on Hon Fred LI's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon NG Leung-sing would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate. Hon NG Leung-sing moved the following amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion and addressed the Council:

To add ", under the premise of safeguarding the rights of investors to operate in compliance with the law and to determine prices," after "That this Council urges the Government".

Question on Hon NG Leung-sing's amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion proposed.

Three Members and Hon Andrew CHENG spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Andrew CHENG was speaking, the President left the chair at 5:50 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

At 5:53 pm, while Hon Andrew CHENG was still speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 17 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Fred LI spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon NG Leung-sing's amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion put.

Hon NG Leung-sing claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 19 were in favour of the amendment, four against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 12 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Fred LI replied.

Question on Hon Fred LI's motion put.

Hon Fred LI claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, 18 were in favour of the motion and seven against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 23 were present, 21 were in favour of the motion and one against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

## Ageing of the population

Hon TAM Yiu-chung moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, in view of the ageing of the population in Hong Kong, this Council urges the Government to respond to the changes in the population profile and actively take the lead in promoting a proper perspective on ageing; encourage the public and private sectors to make the best use of the knowledge and experience of senior citizens; promote "lifelong learning" among the elderly; improve town planning and the design of facilities and housing to create a "barrier-free" public environment; provide sound primary health care services; promote a positive and healthy lifestyle; as well as encourage to establish an "elderly-friendly" the commercial sector service culture, thereby creating a favourable social environment for present and future senior citizens to keep on giving full play to their abilities.

While Hon TAM Yiu-chung was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 8:00 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Fred LI, took the chair.

Question on Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Frederick FUNG and Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Frederick FUNG spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 8:30 pm, while Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

15 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Frederick FUNG moved the following amendment to Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion:

To add "actively consider the implementation of an old age pension scheme to safeguard the livelihood of the retired elderly;" after "this Council urges the Government to".

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon TAM Yiuchung's motion proposed and put.

Hon Frederick FUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 13 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, 16 were in favour of the amendment and five against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions being claimed in respect of the remaining motions to be moved to the motion on Ageing of the population at this meeting, Rule 47(1)(c) of the Rules of Procedure be suspended so that the President may order that the Council do proceed to each of such divisions immediately after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung moved the following amendment to Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion:

To add "consider the financial needs of the elderly and ensure that any adjustments to the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance payment to the elderly will not result in payments that are lower than at the current level;" after "this Council urges the Government to respond to the changes in the population profile and actively take the lead in promoting a proper perspective on ageing;"; and to add "and exempt the elderly from paying the various new and increased fees and charges proposed for medical services" after "provide sound primary health care services".

Question on Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung's amendment to Hon TAM Yiuchung's motion proposed and put.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, six were in favour of the amendment, 14 against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, six against it and five abstained. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung replied.

Question on Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion put and agreed to.

#### <u>Next Meeting</u>

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 20 November 2002 at 2:30 pm.
