<u>Bills</u>

First Reading

Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill 2002

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

<u>Second Reading</u>

Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill 2002

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Members' Motions

The 70% ceiling for residential mortgage loans

Hon James TIEN moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the Government has introduced measures to stabilize the property market, secondary residential property prices have fallen by about 62% from their peak in 1997 and the public's ability in making property loan repayments has increased by about 73% in the same period, thereby considerably reducing the risk of defaults on mortgage loan, this Council asks the Government to adopt measures to assist needy mortgage applicants in securing more conveniently and speedily loans in excess of 70% of the value of their properties, including improving the conditions and procedures for vetting and approving applications under the mortgage insurance scheme or relaxing the guideline for banks on the 70% ceiling for residential mortgage loans, with a view to boosting property transactions, stabilizing the property market, easing deflation and reviving the economy.

Question on Hon James TIEN's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Albert HO would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Albert HO moved the following amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "thereby considerably reducing the risk of defaults on mortgage loan," after "the public's ability in making property loan repayments has increased by about 73% in the same period,"; to delete "assist needy mortgage applicants in securing more conveniently and speedily loans in excess of 70% of the value of their properties, including improving" and substitute with "improve"; and to delete "or relaxing the guideline for banks on the 70% ceiling for residential mortgage loans" and substitute with "and examine the possibility of lowering the mortgage insurance premium, in order to assist needy mortgage applicants in securing more conveniently and speedily loans in excess of 70% of the value of their properties".

While Hon Albert HO was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 4:30 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Question on Hon Albert HO's amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion proposed.

After declaring his interest as the chief executive of a local bank, Dr Hon David LI spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Three more Members and Hon Fred LI spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 5:05 pm, while Hon Fred LI was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 10 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon James TIEN spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Albert HO's amendment to Hon James TIEN's motion put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, five were in favour of the amendment and 20 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 25 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment and 16 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon James TIEN replied.

Question on Hon James TIEN's motion put.

Hon Albert HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 23 were in favour of the motion and three against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 29 were present, 19 were in favour of the motion, eight against it and one abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Enacting laws to implement Article 23 of the Basic Law

Hon James TO moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council considers that enacting laws according to the proposals in the "Consultation Document on Proposals to implement Article 23 of the Basic Law" will reduce the rights and freedoms enjoyed by the people of Hong Kong and damage the rule of law and "One Country, Two Systems".

Question on Hon James TO's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of

Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG moved the following amendment to Hon James TO's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "this Council considers that enacting" after "That" and substitute with ", as the Government will proceed with the work for enacting"; to delete "the proposals in the 'Consultation Document on Proposals to implement" after "laws according to"; to delete "' will reduce" after "Article 23 of the Basic Law" and substitute with ", this Council urges the Government, in drafting the relevant bill, to fully ensure that"; to add "will not be undermined" after "the rights and freedoms enjoyed by the people of Hong Kong"; to delete "damage" before "the rule of law and 'One Country, Two Systems'"; and to add "will not be damaged" after "the rule of law and 'One Country, Two Systems'".

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's amendment to Hon James TO's motion proposed.

The Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion and the amendment.

16 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

The President suspended the meeting at 10:00 pm.

* * * * * *

The Council resumed at 2:30 pm on 12 December 2002 and continued to debate the motion on Enacting laws to implement Article 23 of the Basic Law moved by Hon James TO and the amendment to the motion moved by Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG.

Another 19 Members and Hon NG Leung-sing spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon NG Leung-sing was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:05 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW took the chair.

Five further Members and Hon Howard YOUNG spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 7:00 pm, while Hon Howard YOUNG was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Nine more Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon James TO spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Justice and the Secretary for Security spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's amendment to Hon James TO's motion put.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 28 were present, 23 were in favour of the amendment and five against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 28 were present, 12 were in favour of the amendment, 14 against it and one abstained. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon James TO replied.

Question on Hon James TO's motion put.

Hon James TO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 28 were present, five were in favour of the motion, 22 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 28 were present, 15 were in favour of the motion and 12 against it. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.
