#### Second Reading

Adaptation of Laws Bill 2001

Hon Margaret NG, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Adaptation of Laws Bill 2001, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, she spoke on the Bill in her personal capacity as a Member.

The Chief Secretary for Administration replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

#### Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Adaptation of Laws Bill 2001.

Question that clauses 1, 2 and 3 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedule 3 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Chief Secretary for Administration moved amendments to the aforesaid schedules and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 and 2, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

## Third Reading

#### Proposed resolution under the Public Bus Services Ordinance

#### 1. Schedule of Routes (Long Win Bus Company Limited) Order 2001

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the franchise granted on 22 October 2002 conferring the right on Long Win Bus Company Limited to operate a public bus service on the routes specified in the Schedule of Routes (Long Win Bus Company Limited) Order 2001 (L.N. 72 of 2001) and in any subsequent order made by the Chief Executive in Council shall not, for the entire period of the franchise, be subject to sections 27, 28, 29 and 31 in Part V of the Public Bus Services Ordinance.

Question on the motion proposed.

A Member spoke on the motion.

Hon Eric LI declared interest as an independent, non-executive director of the Long Win Bus Company Limited.

Another four Members spoke on the motion.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 43 Members were present, 40 were in favour of the motion and two abstained. (Voting record in the Appendix.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

# 2. Schedule of Routes (New World First Bus Services Limited) Order 2001

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the franchise granted on 22 October 2002 conferring the right on New World First Bus Services Limited to operate a public bus service on the routes specified in the Schedule of Routes (New World First Bus Services Limited) Order 2001 (L.N. 74 of 2001) and in any subsequent order made by the Chief Executive in Council shall not, for the entire period of the franchise, be subject to sections 27, 28, 29 and 31 in Part V of the Public Bus Services Ordinance.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

# 3. Schedule of Routes (North Lantau and Chek Lap Kok Airport)(Citybus Limited) Order 2001

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the franchise granted on 22 October 2002 conferring the right on Citybus Limited to operate a public bus service on the routes specified in the Schedule of Routes (North Lantau and Chek Lap Kok Airport)(Citybus Limited) Order 2001 (L.N. 75 of 2001) and in any subsequent order made by the Chief Executive in Council shall not, for the entire period of the franchise, be subject to sections 27, 28, 29 and 31 in Part V of the Public Bus Services Ordinance.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

#### Assisting low-income earners and the poor elderly

Hon CHAN Yuen-han moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the current economic and employment situations remain acute, and low-income earners and the poor elderly who are not receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance are very hard up, this Council urges the Government to provide them with different forms of assistance or allowances in transport, medical, housing and education services, etc., so as to improve the livelihood of these people and their families and relieve the pressure on them.

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon LAU Chin-shek spoke on the motion.

While Hon LAU Chin-shek was speaking, the President left the chair at 5:25 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Another 10 Members and Dr Hon TANG Siu-tong spoke on the motion.

At 6:30 pm, while Dr Hon TANG Siu-tong was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

#### Promoting the use of English in Hong Kong

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as English is one of the two official languages in Hong Kong under the Basic Law, and in order to strengthen Hong Kong's position as Asia's world city, this Council urges the Government to adopt measures to promote the use of English with a view to maintaining its importance and improving its standard in Hong Kong.
