(A) Cost Saving proposals of Department of Justice in 2003-04

The Department of Justice is required to achieve 1.8% efficiency saving on the operating expenditure in 2003-04. This 1.8% efficiency saving amounts to roughly \$17.5 M.

The Department of Justice has drawn up a 10-item saving list, the implementation of which will enable the Department to save more than \$18 M in total, slightly exceeding the \$17.5 M saving figure required of us. A breakdown of the amount of the savings is set out as follows –
