# Minutes of meeting held on Thursday, 10 October 2002 at 8:40 am in Conference Room B of the Legislative Council Building

#### I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

<u>Dr LO Wing-lok</u> invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel for the 2002-2003 session in accordance with the election procedures set out in Appendix IV of the House Rules.

#### Election of Chairman

2. <u>Dr LAW Chi-kwong</u> nominated Dr LO Wing-lok and Mr CHAN Kwokkeung and Ms LI Fung-ying seconded the nomination. <u>Dr LO</u> accepted the nomination and <u>Mr CHAN Kwok-keung</u>, the member who had the highest precedence amongst members present, then presided over the election of the Chairman. There being no other nominations, <u>Mr CHAN</u> declared Dr LO elected as Chairman of the Panel.

3. <u>The Chairman</u> took the chair and called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel.

### Election of Deputy Chairman

4. <u>Dr LAW Chi-kwong</u> nominated Mr Michael MAK and Ms LI Fung-ying seconded the nomination. <u>Mr MAK</u> accepted the nomination. As there were no other nominations, <u>the Chairman</u> declared Mr MAK elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel.

### II. Schedule of meetings for the 2002-2003 session

5. <u>Members</u> agreed to hold regular meetings on the second Monday of each month at 8:30 am.

6. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded members that a special meeting had been scheduled for 25 October 2002 at 10:45 am to discuss the findings of the surveys on the proposed amendments to the Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance commissioned by the Government and the private sector and regulatory control of Chinese medicine.

# **III.** Discussion items for next meeting

7. <u>Miss CHAN Yuen-han</u> suggested to discuss measures to control the spread of dengue fever in October 2002. <u>The Chairman</u> pointed out that the Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene had already discussed the subject at a recent meeting. He undertook to liaise with the Chairman of the Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene to fix a date for a joint meeting.

8. <u>Ms LI Fung-ying</u> suggested to discuss the issue of fees charging for the accident and emergency services provided by the Hospital Authority (HA) before the next regular meeting scheduled for 11 November 2002. <u>Members</u> agreed. <u>The Chairman</u> undertook to liaise with the Administration on the date for discussion of this item.

9. <u>Members</u> further agreed to discuss the following items before the end of 2002 -

- (a) Fees charging of drugs classified as "non-essential" by HA proposed by Mr Michael MAK; and
- (b) Financial situation of HA proposed by Dr LAW Chi-kwong.

10. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 8:58 am.
