# **Quarterly Report on The Admission of Talents Scheme**

(From 1 October to 31 December 2002)

## **Employment applications**

Between 1 October to 31 December 2002, 28 entry applications for employment were received under the Scheme. In the same period, 11 applications were approved and 3 were refused or withdrawn. As at end of December 2002, 18 applications were under processing.

## **Employers**

3. A total of eleven employers are involved. The paid-up capital of two of them is below HK\$1 million; one is in the range of HK\$1 million to below HK\$10 million; one is in the range of HK\$10 million to below HK\$100 million; one is over HK\$100 million. The remaining employers also include a partnership company, a government sub-vented institution and four local universities.

### Educational attainment

4. Seven of the approved talents are holders of doctoral degree. Two hold master degrees, one holds bachelor degree and one holds professional certifications in the shipping industry.
