# **INTRODUCTION**

On 27 December 2002, the Electoral Affairs Commission (EAC)

made:

- (a) the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Constituencies) (Amendment) Regulation 2002 ("the GC Amendment Regulation"); and
- (b) the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) (Amendment) Regulation 2002 ("the FC/EC Amendment Regulation").

The brief informs Members of the main provisions of the GC Amendment Regulation and the FC/EC Amendment Regulation.

# BACKGROUND

2. The Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Constituencies) Regulation ("the GC principal regulation") and the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation ("the FC/EC principal regulation") set out the procedural arrangements for the registration of electors for geographical

constituencies (GCs) and functional constituencies (FCs) for the Legislative Council (LegCo) election respectively. The FC/EC principal regulation also provides for the same in respect of the registration of members for the Election Committee (EC) and voters for its subsectors.

3. Following the enactment of the Electoral Provisions (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 2002 (33 of 2002), which provides for a revised cycle for compiling and publishing the electoral registers, certain provisions of the GC principal regulation and the FC/EC principal regulation need to be correspondingly amended to tie in with the changes introduced.

# THE AMENDMENT REGULATIONS

4. The GC Amendment Regulation and the FC/EC Amendment Regulation are at Appendices I and II. The major amendments are highlighted in the following paragraphs.

## (I) The revised cycle of voter registration

5. At present, the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) is required to publish the PR and FR, of electors for GCs and FCs, and of voters for subsectors of the EC not later than 15 April and 25 May respectively each year. The Electoral Provisions (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 2002 (33 of 2002) provides for two sets of publication dates for the electoral registers, with a view to reducing the time gap between the publication of FRs and the polling day for DC and LegCo elections respectively to about two months, as follows:

	Publication of PRs for GCs, FCs and Subsectors	Publication of FRs for GCs, FCs and Subsectors
Publication deadlines in District Council (DC) elections years	15 August	25 September
Publication deadlines in other years	15 June	25 July

6. To tie in with the new voter registration timetable, the various dates concerning different steps in the compilation of the electoral registers as set out in the GC principal regulation and the FC/EC principal regulation will have to be amended accordingly. The new dates for the compilation of the GC and FC

registers are set out at Appendices III and IV respectively.

# (II) Choice of language for entries in the register

7. The opportunity is taken to amend the yardstick by which the language in which an entry is recorded in the register is determined.

8. The GC principal regulation and the FC/EC principal regulation, at present, require that the name of an elector or voter who is a natural person, the name of an authorized representative or the name of an EC member, is to be recorded in Chinese if the person's signature on the application is in Chinese. To avoid uncertainty in determining the language used by an applicant or authorized representative in signing the application forms, it is proposed that the "principal residential address", which is given in either Chinese or English, be used to determine whether that entry should be recorded in Chinese or English.

# **PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

9. There is no need for public consultation because the proposed amendments to the GC principal regulation and the FC/EC principal regulation are basically made to tie in with the new registration cycle as provided for the Electoral Provisions (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 2002 (33 of 2002) only.

# **IMPLICATIONS OF THE AMENDMENT REGULATIONS**

10. The GC Amendment Regulation and the FC/EC Amendment Regulation have no additional financial or staffing implications. The Amendment Regulations are in conformity with the Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights. They have no productivity, environmental or sustainability implications.

# **LEGISLATIVE TIMETABLE**

11. The GC Amendment Regulation and the FC/EC Amendment Regulation will be published in the Gazette on 28 December 2002 and tabled in the LegCo on 8 January 2003.

# PUBLICITY

12. A press release will be issued to announce the publication of the GC Amendment Regulation and the FC/EC Amendment Regulation in the Gazette. A spokesman will be available for answering media enquiries.

## ELECTORAL AFFAIRS COMMISSION (REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS) (LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL GEOGRAPHICAL CONSTITUENCIES) (DISTRICT COUNCIL CONSTITUENCIES)(AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2002

(Made by the Electoral Affairs Commission under section 7 of the Electoral Affairs Commission Ordinance (Cap. 541))

#### 1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 28 February 2003.

#### 2. Interpretation

Section 2 of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Constituencies) Regulation (Cap. 541 sub. leg.) is amended -

(a) in subsection (1) -

- (i) in the definition of "District Council constituency", by adding "or (1A), as the case may be," after "32(1)";
- (ii) in the definition of "Electoral Registration Officer", by adding "or section 1(1) of the Schedule to the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569)" before the semicolon;
- (iii) in the definition of "final register", by adding "or (1A)(b)(i)" after "32(1)(b)(i)";
  - (iv) in the definition of "Legislative Council constituency", by adding "or (1A), as the case may be," after "32(1)";

(vi) in the definition of "register" -

- (B) in paragraph (b), by adding "or

#### How to apply for registration in provisional register

Section 4 is amended -

(a) in subsection (1)(a), by repealing everything after

"Officer -

- (i) if the provisional register is being compiled for a District Council election year, not later than 16 July in that year; or
- (ii) if the provisional register is being compiled for a year which is not a District Council election year, not later than 16 May in that year;";
- (b) in subsection (2), by repealing everything after"Officer -" and substituting -
  - "(a) after 16 March 2002 but not later than 16 July 2003 must be treated by that Officer as an application received on or before 16 July 2003 for registration in the provisional register for 2003;
  - (b) after 16 July in any year subsequent to 2002, if that subsequent year is a District Council election year, must be treated by that Officer as an application received on or before 16 May in the year following that subsequent year for registration in the provisional register to be compiled for that following year; or
  - (c) after 16 May in any year subsequent to 2002, if that subsequent year is not a District Council election year, must be treated by that Officer as an application

received -

- (i) on or before 16 July in the year following that subsequent year, if that following year is a District Council election year, for registration in the provisional register to be compiled for that following year; or
- (ii) on or before 16 May in the year following that subsequent year, if that following year is not a District Council election year, for registration in the provisional register to be compiled for that following year.".

## 5. Electoral Registration Officer to determine whether or not applicant is eligible for registration and may ask for additional information

Section 5 is amended -

- (a) in subsection (2), by repealing everything after"within" and substituting "the specified period.";
- (b) by adding -

"(11) In this section, "specified period" (指明期間), in relation to a requirement made under subsection (2), means -

(a) if the first 25 July thatfollows the making of the

requirement falls in a District Council election year, a period ending not later than that 25 July; or

(b) in any other case, a periodending not later than the first25 May that follows the makingof the requirement,

specified by the Electoral Registration

Officer.".

6. Electoral Registration Officer may make inquiries regarding persons registered in the existing final register

  - (A) by repealing "28 February in the current year" and substituting "the date referred to in section 7(3)(a) or (b), as the case may be";
  - (B) in subparagraph (i), by repealing
     "16 March in the current year" and
     substituting "the relevant date
     specified in subsection (5)";
- (iii) in paragraph (b), by repealing "16 March in the current year" and substituting "the relevant date specified in subsection (5)";
- (b) in subsection (4)(a), by repealing "16 March in the current year" and substituting "the relevant date specified in subsection (5)";

(c) by adding -

"(5) For the purposes of subsections
(1)(a)(i) and (b) and (4)(a), the relevant

## Electoral Registration Officer to publish a notice that omissions list is available for public inspection

Section 10 is amended -

- (a) in subsection (1), by repealing "or section 1(6) of Schedule 3 to that Ordinance, as the case may require";
- (b) in subsection (2), by repealing everything after"(Cap. 542)" and substituting -

9. Electoral Registration Officer to correct entries in existing final register in compiling next provisional register

Section 11(5) is amended by repealing everything after "of -" and substituting -

- "(a) the provisional register for 2003, after 29 April 2002 but not later than 16 July 2003; or
- (b) any subsequent provisional register for -
  - (i) a District Council election year, after 29June in the preceding year but not later than16 July in the current year; or
  - (ii) a year which is not a District Council election year -
    - (A) after 29 August in the preceding year, if that preceding year is a District Council election year, but not later than 16 May in the current year; or
    - (B) after 29 June in the preceding year, if that preceding year is not a District Council election year, but not later than 16 May in the current year.".

"Officer -" and substituting -

- "(i) in the case of the provisional register for 2003, during the period beginning on 17 March 2002 and ending on 16 July 2003; or
- (ii) in the case of any subsequent provisional register to be compiled for -
  - (A) a District Council election year, during the period beginning on 17 May in the preceding year and ending on 16 July in the current year; or
  - (B) a year which is not a District Council election year -
    - (I) during the period beginning on 17 July in the preceding year, if that preceding year is a District Council election year, and ending on 16 May in the current year; or
    - (II) during the period beginning on 17 May in the preceding year, if that preceding year is not a District Council election year, and ending on 16 May in the current year.".
- 11. Electoral Registration Officer to publish a notice that provisional register is available for public inspection

Section 13 is amended -

(a) in subsection (1), by repealing everything before"the Gazette" and substituting -

"(1) The Electoral Registration Officer must publish, every year -

(a) in the case of a provisional

register compiled for a District Council election year, not later than 15 August; or

 (b) in the case of a provisional register compiled for a year which is not a District Council election year, not later than 15 June,

in";

- (b) in subsection (2)(a), by adding "relevant" before
   "period";
- (c) in subsection (3), by repealing everything after

- (ii) in relation to a final register being compiled for a year which is not a District Council election year, not later than 11 July in that year; and".

# 17. What is to be contained in final register

Section 19(5) is amended by repealing everything after "final register" and substituting -

"to be compiled for -

- (a) a District Council election year, only decisions made by the Revising Officer during the period beginning on 15 August and ending on 11 September in that year; or
- (b) a year which is not a District Council election year, only decisions made by the Revising Officer during the period beginning

on 15 June and ending on 11 July in that year, are to be taken into account for the purposes of subsection (1)(b), (2), (3) or (4).".

18. Electoral Registration Officer to publish notice of final register and to make final register available for public inspection

Section 20 is amended -

(a) in subsection (1), by repealing "not later than 25May in each year, in" and substituting -

"every year -

- (a) in the case of a final register
   compiled for a District Council
   election year, not later than
   25 September; or
- (b) in the case of a final register compiled for a year which is not a District Council election year, not later than 25 July,

in";

(b) in subsection (6), by adding "or (1A)(b)(i), as the case may be," after "32(1)(b)(i)".

#### 19. Offences and penalties

Section 22 is amended -

- (a) in subsection (7) -
  - (i) in paragraph (a), by repealing "and sections 5, 14 and 23 of Schedule 2 to that Ordinance; and" and substituting a semicolon;

(ii) in paragraph (b), by repealing the full stop and substituting "; and";

(iii) by adding -

- "(c) sections 14, 20 and 26 of the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569) and sections 9, 18 and 30 of the Schedule to that Ordinance.";
- (b) in subsection (8) -
  - (i) in paragraph (a), by repealing "and sections 5 and 14 of Schedule 2 to that Ordinance; and" and substituting a semicolon;
  - (ii) in paragraph (b), by repealing the full stop and substituting "; and";
  - (iii) by adding -
    - "(c) sections 14 and 20 of the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569) and sections 9 and 18 of the Schedule to that Ordinance.";

(c) by adding -

"(9) In this section, "election" (選舉) has the meaning assigned to it by section 21(5).". Made this 27th day of December 2002.

#### Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Constituencies) Regulation (Cap. 541 sub. leg.) -

- (a) to revise the dates in relation to -
  - (i) the application for registration in electoral registers;
  - (ii) the requirement for particulars or proof relating to application for registration, and the response thereto;

- (iii) the making of inquiries regarding persons registered, and the reply thereto;
  - (iv) the correction of entries in electoral
     registers;
    - (v) the publication and inspection of omissions lists and electoral registers; and
- (vi) the lodging, and delivery of copies, of notices of objection and notices of claim, following the adjustment of the cycle for the compilation of electoral registers as effected by the Electoral Provisions (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 2002 (33 of 2002);
- (b) to provide that whether the name of a person is to be recorded in an electoral register in English or Chinese will depend on whether the person's principal residential address (instead of the person's signature) is written or printed in English or Chinese on the person's application; and
- (c) to make other consequential and related amendments.
