Frontier Closed Area (Permission to Enter) (Amendment) Notice 2003

(Made under section 38A(1) of the Public Order

Ordinance (Cap. 245))

1. Schedule amended

The Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area (Permission to Enter) Notice (Cap. 245 sub. leg. H) is amended---

(a) in Part I---

(i) in item 1, in the second column, by adding "the Mainland of" before "China";

(ii) in item 2---

(A) by repealing everything in the second column and substituting---

"The drivers of and through passengers on

road vehicles to or from the Mainland of China, entering or leaving via Man Kam To Boundary Control Point. ";

(B) in the fourth column---

(I) by repealing "GR KV 036937" and substituting "KK 0391 9348";

(II) by repealing "Border Crossing Point or from that Crossing" and substituting "Boundary Control Point or from that Control";

(iii) in item 2A---

(A) by repealing everything in the second column and substituting---

"The drivers of and through passengers on road vehicles to or from the Mainland of China, entering or leaving via Sha Tau Kok Boundary Control Point. ";

(B) in the fourth column---

(I) by repealing "GR KV 129952" and substituting "KK 1324 9502";

(II) by repealing "Border Crossing Point or from that Crossing" and substituting "Boundary Control Point or from that Control";

(iv) by adding---

Explanatory Note

This Notice amends the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area (Permission to Enter) Notice (Cap. 245 sub. leg. H) ("principal Notice") in order to---

(a) grant permission to drivers of and through passengers on road vehicles to or from the Mainland of China via Lok Ma Chau Boundary Control Point to enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area at any time, subject to the conditions specified in the Notice;

(b) grant permission to drivers of taxis and public light buses on a scheduled service who enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area for the purpose of carrying the persons entering or leaving Lok Ma Chau Boundary Control Point, to enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area for the period beginning on 0000 hours and ending with 0630 hours each day, subject to the conditions specified in the Notice;

(c) bring the relevant provisions of the principal Notice into conformity with the status of Hong Kong as a Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China; and

(d) update the names of the arrival and departure facilities on the Man Kam To Road and the Sha Tau Kok Road.
