1. Forms

Paragraph 9 in part (a) of the declaration in Form 4 of the Schedule to the Admission and Registration Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg.) is repealed and the following substituted---

"9. I have accumulated the number of CPD accreditation points that is required by section 5 of the Continuing Professional Development Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg.) to be accumulated by the end of my period of employment as a trainee solicitor."

Explanatory Note

These Rules amend Form 4 of the Schedule to the Admission and Registration Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg.) to the effect that where a trainee solicitor has accumulated the number of CPD accreditation points required by section 5 of the Continuing Professional Development Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg.) by the end of his period of employment as a trainee solicitor, he can apply for a certificate of eligibility for admission as a solicitor.
