Second Reading

Supplementary Appropriation (2002-2003) Bill

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 18 June 2003 resumed.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Supplementary Appropriation (2002-2003) Bill.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury reported that

the Supplementary Appropriation (2002-2003) Bill

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

<u>Proposed resolution under the Air Passenger Departure Tax</u> <u>Ordinance</u>

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that with effect from the day immediately following the expiry of 3 months from the date on which this Resolution is passed the First Schedule to the Air Passenger Departure Tax Ordinance be amended in item 1 by repealing "\$80" and substituting "\$120".

Members' Motions

Calling on the Chief Executive Mr TUNG Chee-hwa to step down

Hon Emily LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as there has been retrogression in human rights, the rule of law and economic development in Hong Kong and democratization of the political system has remained stagnant under the administration of the Chief Executive Mr TUNG Cheehwa, prompting the public to make repeated demands for him to step down, this Council calls on Mr TUNG to take the responsibility and resign in accordance with the wishes of the people.

Question on the motion proposed.

Five Members and Dr Hon David LI spoke on the motion.

While Dr Hon David LI was speaking, the President left the chair at 5:35 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Another seven Members and Hon Cyd HO spoke on the motion.

At 6:25 pm, while Hon Cyd HO was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Five more Members, the Secretary for Justice, the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs and the Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion.

Hon Emily LAU replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Emily LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, five were in favour of the motion and 22 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, 16 were in favour of the motion and nine against it. (Voting record in the Appendix.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Facing up to the transport needs of people with disabilities

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council expresses strong dissatisfaction with the failure of the government departments concerned to face up to the transport needs of people with disabilities and give full effect to the relevant motion passed by this Council in the 2002-03 session, and demands the Administration to act immediately to press various public transport operators to offer half-fare concessions to people with disabilities and to improve their facilities so as to reduce the barriers to them, as well as to expeditiously improve the Rehabus service.

Question on the motion proposed.

11 Members and the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works spoke on the motion.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 15 October 2003 at 2:30 pm.
