<u>Bills</u>

Second Reading

Import and Export (Facilitation) Bill 2003

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 25 June 2003 resumed.

One Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Import and Export (Facilitation) Bill 2003**.

Question that clauses 1 to 6 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 to 5 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology reported that

the Import and Export (Facilitation) Bill 2003

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

Proposed resolution under the District Court Ordinance

The Chief Secretary for Administration moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that, with effect from 1 December 2003, the District Court Ordinance (Cap. 336) be amended in the provisions specified below by repealing "\$600,000" wherever it appears and substituting "\$1,000,000" -

(a) section 32(1) and (3);

- (b) section 33(1)(b);
- (c) section 37(2)(i), (ii) and (iv); and
- (d) section 52(1)(a) and (d).

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

<u>Proposed resolution under the Mutual Legal Assistance in</u> Criminal Matters Ordinance

The Secretary for Security moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters (Netherlands) Order, made by the Chief Executive in Council on 7 October 2003, be approved.

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon James TO, Chairman of the Subcommittee on the Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters (Ireland) Order and the Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters (Netherlands) Order, spoke on the motion.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

Appointment of a select committee

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council appoints a select committee to inquire into the handling of the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome outbreak by the Government and the Hospital Authority in order to examine the performance and accountability of the Government and the Hospital Authority and their officers at policy-making and management levels in that regard; and that in the performance of its duties the committee be authorized under section 9(2) of the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance (Cap. 382) to exercise the powers conferred by section 9(1) of that Ordinance.

Question on the motion proposed.

Five Members spoke on the motion.

Hon Michael MAK declared his interest as an employee of the Hospital Authority and spoke on the motion.

The Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Reducing gas, electricity and water charges

Hon TAM Yiu-chung moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as various public transport operators have reduced their fares or offered concessions to passengers, this Council urges the Government to adopt the following measures to further alleviate the burden on the public and the commercial and industrial sectors, and speed up the economic recovery of Hong Kong, thereby promoting employment:

- (a) expeditiously discussing with the gas company and the two power companies and encouraging them to reduce their charges or provide concessions to consumers;
- (b) lowering the permitted rates of return of the two power companies in the interim review on their Schemes of Control; and
- (c) expeditiously consulting with the Government of Guangdong Province on entering into a new agreement on the supply of Dongjiang water and introducing a clause that allows flexibility in the supply of water, and returning to consumers all the savings derived from the purchase of Dongjiang water.

Question on Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Fred LI would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Fred LI moved the following amendment to Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "as various" after "That," and substitute with "although individual"; to add "through interchange schemes, not all members of the public have benefited from these concessions; hence" after "public transport operators have reduced their fares or offered concessions to passengers"; to delete "lowering the permitted rates of return" after "(b)" and substitute with "striving to amend the Schemes of Control"; to add ", including the method for calculating their returns," after "of the two power companies"; to delete "on

their Schemes of Control" after "in the interim review"; and to add ", as well as exploring other water sources so as to increase the supply of potable water" after "and returning to consumers all the savings derived from the purchase of Dongjiang water".

Question on Hon Fred LI's amendment to Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion proposed.

15 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Fred LI's amendment to Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion put.

Hon IP Kwok-him claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 18 were present, 12 were in favour of the amendment, three against it and three abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 17 were in favour of the amendment, one against it and five abstained. (Voting record in the Appendix.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was agreed.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung replied.

Question on Hon TAM Yiu-chung's motion as amended by Hon Fred LI put and agreed to.

Expectations for the implementation of policies

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to prudently consider the expectations of the Members of this Council for the 2004 Policy Address.

While Dr Hon YEUNG Sum was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 7:48 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

10 Members and Hon Margaret NG spoke on the motion.

At 9:10 pm, while Hon Margaret NG was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 14 Members and the Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 5 November 2003 at 2:30 pm.
