The Secretary for Home Affairs replied.

4. Hon Michael MAK asked Question 4.

The Secretary for the Civil Service replied.

After declaring his interest as having acted as chairman of seminars on managing work pressure conducted by various government departments and provided free counseling service to some civil servants, Hon Michael MAK asked a supplementary and the Secretary for the Civil Service replied.

Another six Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for the Civil Service replied.

<u>First Reading</u>

Employees Compensation Assistance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Employees Compensation Assistance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Members' Motions

Education policy

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council opposes the Government's reduction in spending on education, and urges the Government to implement small-class teaching in primary and secondary schools by phases, adopt the four-year normative undergraduate structure as early as possible, and provide funding support for existing associate degree programmes run by universities, so as to provide students with quality education and nurture future talents for Hong Kong.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung and Hon Tommy CHEUNG would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung and Hon Tommy CHEUNG respectively spoke on the motion and their amendments.

Four Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

After declaring his interest that he was working in the education field in Hong Kong, Dr Hon YEUNG Sum spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Another 10 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong spoke on the amendments.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW sought elucidation of the remarks made by Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong in his speech and Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong, with the President's permission, elucidated.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion:

To add "expresses dissatisfaction with the Government for its failure to honour its pledge made in the past Policy Addresses in regard to investment in education and" after "That this Council"; and to add "at the same time" after "opposes the Government's reduction in spending on education, and". Question on Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Mankwong's motion proposed and put.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 16 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, 21 were in favour of the amendment and four against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions being claimed in respect of the motion or amendments thereto on "Education policy" at this meeting, Rule 47(1)(c) of the Rules of Procedure be suspended so that the President may order that the Council do proceed to each of such divisions immediately after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon Tommy CHEUNG moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion:

To add "unreasonable" after "That this Council opposes the Government's"; to delete "implement small-class teaching in primary and secondary schools by phases, adopt the four-year normative undergraduate structure as early as possible, and provide funding support for existing" after "and urges the Government to" and substitute with "comprehensively review the use of educational resources on condition that tuition will not be raised, and to actively assist the institutions in developing their education-related businesses with a view to increasing income and reducing expenditure, in order that the subsidized"; and to add "can switch smoothly to a selffinancing basis; furthermore, the Government should examine the implementation of small-class teaching in primary and secondary schools, and adoption of the six-year secondary education structure and four-year normative undergraduate structure under the principle of appropriate deployment of resources" "associate degree programmes after run by universities".

Question on Hon Tommy CHEUNG's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Mankwong's motion proposed and put. Hon Mrs Selina CHOW claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 20 were in favour of the amendment and six against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 16 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong replied.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion put.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, 12 were in favour of the motion and 15 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, 22 were in favour of the motion and three against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Improving the competitiveness of Hong Kong's container freight industry

Hon Kenneth TING moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to promptly address the problem of Hong Kong's container terminals rapidly losing their competitive edge, seriously examine the reasons for the decline in the competitiveness of the local container freight industry, and expeditiously take corresponding measures to reclaim Hong Kong's leading position as a maritime and logistics centre.

Question on Hon Kenneth TING's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon SIN Chung-kai would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following amendment to Hon Kenneth TING's motion and addressed the Council:

To add ", including conducting feasibility studies on the selection of site for and the planning of Container Terminal 10 in view of the construction of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, so as" after "and expeditiously take corresponding measures".

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Kenneth TING's motion proposed.

One Member and Hon HUI Cheung-ching spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon HUI Cheung-ching was speaking, the President left the chair at 7:18 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Another five Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Kenneth TING spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 7:58 pm, while the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Kenneth TING's motion put and agreed to.

Hon Kenneth TING replied.

Question on Hon Kenneth TING's motion as amended by Hon SIN Chung-kai put and agreed to.

Appointing least number of District Council members

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as more than one million voters cast their votes in the District Council elections on 23 November, the appointment of District Council members by the Chief Executive will be tantamount to changing the results of voting by the public, this Council urges the Chief Executive to appoint the least number of District Council members in accordance with the law and respect the choices made by more than one million voters who cast their votes in the District Council elections.

Question on the motion proposed.

After declaring his interest as being an appointed member of Eastern District Council, Hon Henry WU spoke on the motion.

Another two Members and Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong spoke on the motion.

While Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong was speaking, Hon Andrew WONG interrupted and raised a point of order on whether Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's speech contained offensive language about him as a Member of the Council. The President suspended the meeting at 9:36 pm.

The Council resumed at 9:44 pm.

The President stated that she had reviewed the speech of Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong. She ruled that Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's statement was not offensive to Members of the Council and asked Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong to continue with his speech.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong continued to speak on the motion.

Two other Members spoke on the motion.

After declaring his interest as being a member of North District Council, Hon WONG Sing-chi spoke on the motion.

13 more Members, the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke on the motion.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum replied.

With the President's permission, Hon NG Leung-sing elucidated some points he had made earlier which had been misunderstood by Dr Hon YEUNG Sum.

Question on the motion put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, eight were in favour of the motion, 16 against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 28 were present, 17 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 10 December 2003 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 11:51 pm.
