First Reading

Waste Disposal (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill 2003

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Waste Disposal (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill 2003

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Employees Compensation Assistance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 3 December 2003 resumed.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Employees** Compensation Assistance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003.

Question that clauses 1 to 4 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour reported that

the Employees Compensation Assistance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

As the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food, who was next to move two motions, was not in the Chamber, the President suspended the meeting at 3:52 pm.

The Council resumed at 4:00 pm.

Proposed resolution under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulation 2003; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulation 2003,

made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 26 November 2003, be approved.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulation 2003; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulation 2003,

made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 26 November 2003, be approved.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

<u>Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General</u> <u>Clauses Ordinance</u>

Hon Margaret NG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Summary Disposal of Complaints (Solicitors) Rules, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 251 of 2003 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 26 November 2003, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 14 January 2004.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

Hon Cyd HO moved the following motion and addressed the Council as the Chairman of the Subcommittee on Commencement Notices under the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, Chinese Medicine (Fees) Regulation and Chinese Medicine Regulation, and then in her personal capacity as a Member:

Resolved that the -

(a) Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 227 of 2003;

- (b) Chinese Medicine (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 549 sub. leg. E) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 228 of 2003; and
- (c) Chinese Medicines Regulation (Cap. 549 sub. leg. F) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 229 of 2003,

and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 29 October 2003, be repealed.

Question on the motion proposed.

Two Members spoke on the motion.

Hon Margaret NG spoke on the motion and declared her interest that she, as a barrister, had represented a client in an appeal against the authorities' refusal to register her client as a Chinese medical practitioner.

Another two Members and the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion.

Hon Cyd HO replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Cyd HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, four were in favour of the motion, 19 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 25 were present, 14 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Digital 21 Strategy

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council considers that the Government should take the opportunity of reviewing the Digital 21 Strategy to promote the use of information technology ("IT") by local enterprises, the public and the Government itself so as to achieve the target of enhancing Hong Kong's competitiveness and creating business opportunities for the IT industry; the Government should also tie in with the Mainland's IT policies and understand the complementary advantages of the IT industries in both places, with a view to facilitating cooperation between enterprises in Hong Kong and the Mainland in receiving IT goods orders from the world market, developing products jointly or promoting Mainland products in the world market, thereby achieving mutual benefits.

While Hon SIN Chung-kai was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 5:17 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Howard YOUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon SIN Chung-kai's motion and addressed the Council:

To add "enhance the exploitation of the market opportunities in the Mainland for the local telecommunications industry brought about by the Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement," after "the Government should also"; to delete "co-operation between" after "with a view to facilitating"; and to delete "and the Mainland" after "enterprises in Hong Kong" and substitute with "in developing the Mainland market or co-operating with the Mainland enterprises".

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon SIN Chungkai's motion proposed.

Six Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon SIN Chung-kai spoke on the amendment.

At 6:11 pm, while Hon SIN Chung-kai was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon SIN Chungkai's motion put and agreed to.

Hon SIN Chung-kai replied.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's motion as amended by Hon Howard YOUNG put and agreed to.

Labelling Scheme on Nutrition Information

Hon Fred LI moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to expeditiously introduce a mandatory labelling scheme on nutrition information for prepackaged food and draw up a legislative timetable to implement, in three years' time, the first and second phases of the scheme as proposed in the consultation paper, so as to facilitate consumers in choosing foods that are beneficial to health; besides, as the international community has not yet arrived at a consensus on how to regulate foods for infants and foods prepared for people with special dietary needs, this Council also asks the Government to carry out a study as soon as possible, to explore the feasibility of including these food products in the scheme.

Question on Hon Fred LI's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Mrs Selina CHOW would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "the Government to expeditiously introduce" after "That this Council urges" and substitute with "that, before introducing"; to delete "and draw up a legislative timetable to implement, in three years' time, the first and second phases of the scheme as proposed in the consultation paper" after "prepackaged food" and substitute with ", the Government should conduct a regulatory impact assessment, taking into account the views of the public, consumers, importers, distributors, wholesalers, suppliers and retailers, and make reference to relevant overseas experience and practices"; and to delete "; besides, as the international community has not yet arrived at a consensus on how to regulate foods for infants and foods prepared for people with special dietary needs, this Council also asks the Government to carry out a study as soon as possible, to explore the feasibility of including these food products in the scheme" after "foods that are beneficial to health".

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion proposed.

Eight Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Fred LI spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Fred LI's motion put.

Hon Fred LI claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 12 were in favour of the amendment and 12 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, three were in favour of the amendment and 18 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Fred LI replied.

Question on Hon Fred LI's motion put.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 13 were in favour of the motion, 10 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 22 were present, 19 were in favour of the motion and two against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

The President wished Members a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 7 January 2004 at 2:30 pm.
