A Member spoke on the motion.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

**Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General
Clauses Ordinance**

Hon HUI Cheung-ching moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Electoral Affairs Commission (Financial Assistance for Legislative Council Elections) (Application and Payment Procedure) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 269 of 2003 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 7 January 2004, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 25 February 2004.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Motion of Thanks

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council thanks the Chief Executive for his address.

Question on the motion proposed. The President stated that Dr Hon YEUNG Sum would move an amendment to the motion. The motion and the proposed amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

The President announced the commencement of the first debate session, which covered the following policy areas: commerce and industry, economic services, financial affairs, information technology and broadcasting and labour.

Four Members spoke.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW spoke and declared her interest as the Chairman of Hong Kong Tourism Board.

Another 17 Members and Hon CHAN Yuen-han spoke.

While Hon CHAN Yuen-han was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:15 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Seven more Members and Hon Michael MAK spoke.

At 7:14 pm, while Hon Michael MAK was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Six more Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 8:11 pm.

The Council resumed at 8:21 pm.

The Financial Secretary, the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury, the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke.

The President announced the end of the first debate session and suspended the meeting at 9:22 pm.

The Council resumed at 2:30 pm on 5 February 2004 and continued to debate the Motion of Thanks moved by Hon Miriam LAU and the amendment to the motion to be moved by Dr Hon YEUNG Sum.

The President announced the commencement of the second debate session, which covered the following policy areas: food safety and environmental hygiene, health services and welfare services.

11 Members spoke.

Hon Bernard CHAN declared his interest as the chairperson of the Hong Kong Council of Social Service and spoke.

Another two Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 4:33 pm.

The Council resumed at 4:46 pm.

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke.

The President announced the end of the second debate session and the commencement of the third debate session, which covered the following policy areas: education, home affairs and manpower planning.

Seven Members and Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung spoke.

While Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:02 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Three Members spoke.

Hon Henry WU spoke and declared his interest as a member of the Board of Trustees of The Lord Wilson Heritage Trust.

Another three Members and Hon Abraham SHEK spoke.

At 6:52 pm, while Hon Abraham SHEK was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Two more Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 7:07 pm.

The Council resumed at 7:20 pm.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke.

The President announced the end of the third debate session and the commencement of the fourth debate session, which covered the following policy areas: housing, planning, lands and works, environmental affairs and transport.

14 Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 9:45 pm.

The Council resumed at 9:55 pm.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands and the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works spoke.

The President announced the end of the fourth debate session and suspended the meeting at 10:40 pm.

The Council resumed at 2:30 pm on 6 February 2004 and continued to debate the Motion of Thanks moved by Hon Miriam LAU and the amendment to the motion to be moved by Dr Hon YEUNG Sum.

The President announced the commencement of the fifth debate session, which covered the following policy areas: administration of justice and legal services, constitutional affairs, public service and security.

27 Members and Hon Albert CHAN spoke.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:08 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Fred LI, took the chair.

Two other Members and Hon Martin LEE spoke.

Hon Martin LEE drew the attention of the President's Deputy to the absence of a quorum. The President's Deputy directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting.

At 6:26 pm, the President resumed the chair.

A quorum was then present and Hon Martin LEE continued to speak.

Hon Andrew WONG spoke. While he was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:45 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Fred LI, took the chair.

Hon TSANG Yok-sing spoke. At 6:57 pm, while he was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Three more Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 7:29 pm.

The Council resumed at 7:45 pm.

The Secretary for Justice, the Secretary for Security, the Secretary for the Civil Service, the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs and the Chief Secretary for Administration spoke.

The President announced the end of the fifth debate session.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the amendment.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add ", but regrets his failure to respond to the public's democratic aspirations for electing the Chief Executive and all Members of the Legislative Council by universal suffrage in 2007 and 2008 respectively, and urges the Government to immediately commence its consultation on constitutional review; this Council also demands that the Task Force on Constitutional Development proactively relay to the Central Government Hong Kong people's strong aspirations for democracy, and operate in a transparent and open manner, keeping the public informed of the progress of the discussions" after "That this Council thanks the Chief Executive for his address".

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, four were in favour of the amendment and 23 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 30 were present, 17 were in favour of the amendment and 12 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU replied.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's motion put.

Hon Emily LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, 23 were in favour of the motion and four against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 30 were present, 13 were in favour of the motion and 16 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 11 February 2004 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 8:56 pm.

INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 34(2) of the Interpretation and
General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1))

PARTICULARS RELATING TO CANDIDATES ON BALLOT PAPERS
(LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL) REGULATION

RESOLVED that the Particulars Relating to Candidates on
Ballot Papers (Legislative Council) Regulation,
published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 263 of 2003
and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 17
December 2003, be amended -

(a) in section 2(1), in the definition of "relevant
cut-off date", by repealing "March" where it twice
appears and substituting "April";

(b) in section 3 -

(i) by repealing subsection (3) and
substituting -

"(3) The particulars referred to in subsection (2)(a) are the particulars set out in any one of the following paragraphs, with or without the particulars specified in item 4 of the Schedule -

- (a) the particulars specified in item 1 or item 2 or both of the Schedule and relating to not more than 3 prescribed bodies;
- (b) the particulars specified in item 3 of the Schedule and relating to the candidate; or
- (c) the particulars specified in item 1 or item 2 or both of the Schedule and relating to not more than 2 prescribed bodies, and the particulars specified in item 3 of the

Schedule and relating
to the candidate.";

(ii) by repealing subsection (4)(e) and
substituting -

"(e) where the subject of request
relates to one or more
prescribed bodies, must be
accompanied by a consent given,
during the relevant nomination
period, by the body or each of
the bodies, as the case may be,
in relation to the request in
accordance with section 5(1).";

(c) in section 4 -

(i) by repealing subsections (3) and (4) and
substituting -

"(3) The particulars referred
to in subsection (2)(a)(i) are the
particulars set out in any one of
the following paragraphs, with or
without the particulars specified in
item 4 of the Schedule -

(a) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of
the Schedule and
relating to not more

than 3 prescribed
bodies;

(b) the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to one or
both of the
candidates on the
nomination list
concerned;

(c) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of
the Schedule and
relating to one
prescribed body, and
the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to one or
both of the
candidates on the
nomination list
concerned; or

(d) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of

the Schedule and
relating to 2
prescribed bodies,
and the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to one of
the candidates on the
nomination list
concerned.

(4) The particulars referred
to in subsection (2)(b)(i) are the
particulars set out in any one of
the following paragraphs, with or
without the particulars specified in
item 4 of the Schedule -

(a) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of
the Schedule and
relating to not more
than 3 prescribed
bodies;

(b) the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to not more

than 3 candidates on
the nomination list
concerned;

- (c) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of
the Schedule and
relating to one
prescribed body, and
the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to not more
than 2 candidates on
the nomination list
concerned; or
- (d) the particulars
specified in item 1
or item 2 or both of
the Schedule and
relating to 2
prescribed bodies,
and the particulars
specified in item 3
of the Schedule and
relating to one of
the candidates on the

nomination list
concerned.";

(ii) in subsection (5) -

(A) in paragraph (d), by repealing "
and" and substituting "and
particulars to identify the
candidate or candidates shown on the
photograph or photographs";

(B) in paragraph (e), by repealing the
full stop and substituting "; and";

(C) by adding -

"(f) where the subject of
request includes the
particulars specified in
item 4 of the Schedule,
must specify the candidate
or candidates to whom the
particulars relate.";

(d) in section 7, by adding "and whether and how to
further include any indication on the ballot paper
to show the candidate or candidates to whom the
particulars relate" after "paper";

(e) in section 15(1), by repealing "21" and
substituting "14";

(f) in section 19(1), by adding "and the reasons for
the decision" after "the decision";

- (g) in section 23(7), by adding "and the reasons for the decision" after "the decision";
- (h) in the Schedule, by renumbering items 2, 3 and 4 as items 4, 2 and 3 respectively.
