First Reading

Undesirable Medical Advertisements (Amendment) Bill 2004 Construction Industry Council Bill

The Bills were read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Undesirable Medical Advertisements (Amendment) Bill 2004

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Construction Industry Council Bill

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Construction Industry Levy (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 9 April 2003 resumed.

Hon LAU Ping-cheung, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Construction Industry Levy (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill.

One Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Construction Industry Levy (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003.

Question that clauses 1, 2, 6, 9, 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 23 to 29, 33, 34, 35, 37, 38 and 41 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, 30, 31, 32, 36, 39 and 40 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, 30, 31, 32, 36, 39 and 40, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Education and Manpower reported that

the Construction Industry Levy (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2003

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

<u>Motions</u>

<u>Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance</u>

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

- (1) the functions exercisable by the Chief Secretary for Administration by virtue of sections 14(4) and 15(2) of the Housing Ordinance (Cap. 283) be transferred to the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands;
- (2) for the purpose of giving full effect to paragraph (1) -
 - (a) sections 14(4) and 15(2) of the Housing Ordinance (Cap. 283) be amended by repealing "Chief Secretary for Administration" and substituting "Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands";
 - (b) the Specification of Public Office (L.N. 471 of 1996) be repealed.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

Demands on the Budget

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council demands that, when drawing up the 2004-05 Budget, the Government do not substantially reduce its spending on social welfare, medical services and education, and continue to freeze the government fees and charges which directly affect people's livelihood.

While Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:02 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon CHAN Kam-lam and Hon Mrs Selina CHOW would move amendments to the motion and that Hon SIN Chung-kai would also move an amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's proposed amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion, the two amendments and the amendment to the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW and Hon SIN Chung-kai spoke respectively on the motion and the amendments.

Eight Members and Dr Hon LUI Ming-wah spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 7:30 pm, while Dr Hon LUI Ming-wah's was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 11 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam moved the following amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion:

To delete "do not" after "the Government" and substitute with "allocate additional resources to formulate policies that promote economic development, including actively promoting Hong Kong as the off-shore centre for Renminbi so as to consolidate Hong Kong's status as an international financial centre, continuing to perfect the Mainland and Hong Kong Economic Partnership Arrangement, and actively Closer exploring the role of and the business opportunities for Hong Kong in the free-trade area to be set up between the Mainland and the Association of South-East Asian Nation, so as to bring into full play Hong Kong's function as the link between the Mainland and the international community and further enhance economic co-operation with the Mainland and countries of the world; furthermore, this Council also demands that, in the light of the economic recovery, the Government do not further"; to delete "," after "its spending on social welfare" and substitute with "and"; to delete "and education," after "medical services"; to add "keep its pledge to invest in education, as well as" before "continue to freeze the government fees and charges"; and to add ", and relieve the tax burden on the public" after "which directly affect people's livelihood".

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion proposed.

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment:

To add "and improving corporate governance and enhancing protection of small investors' interests," after "the offshore centre for Renminbi"; to add "("CEPA")" after "the Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement"; and to add "as well as exploring how to promote CEPA to a higher level and form a Greater China Trade Area covering the Mainland, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macau," after "the Association of South-East Asian Nation,".

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment proposed and put.

Hon SIN Chung-kai claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 19 were present, five were in favour of the amendment, five against it and nine abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 16 were in favour of the amendment and seven against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in respect of the motion on Demands on the Budget or its other amendments, the Council do proceed to each of such divisions immediately after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion put.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 20 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 11 abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present and 23 were in favour of the amendment. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion:

To add "and business environment" after "and continue to freeze the government fees and charges which directly affect people's livelihood".

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong replied.

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's motion as amended by Hon Mrs Selina CHOW put and agreed to.

Border industrial zone

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to expeditiously formulate planning and support measures which are conducive to the development of a border industrial zone, and take the initiative to consult the relevant Mainland authorities with a view to seeking a synergy of the strengths of the Mainland and Hong Kong in supporting the development of the advantaged industries and related trades, so as to attract local, Mainland and foreign investors, promote Hong Kong's economic growth, and create more local employment opportunities.

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon SIN Chung-kai would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion and addressed the Council:

To add "; the Government should also discuss with the Shenzhen Municipal Government to explore the setting up of a Hong Kong-Shenzhen river-loop area development company to jointly develop a border river-loop industrial zone" after "in supporting the development of the advantaged industries and related trades".

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion proposed.

Five Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion put and agreed to.

Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG replied.

Question on Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG's motion as amended by Hon SIN Chung-kai put and agreed to.
